Recipe Corner

Bacon-wrapped BBQ Chicken

- 8 chicken tenders (about 1 pound)
- 1/2 tsp. paprika or ground cumin (opt.)
- 8 slices bacon
- 1/2 cup barbecue sauce

1. Preheat broiler. Line broiler pan with foil.
2. Sprinkle chicken tenders with paprika,. Wrap each chicken tender with 1 slice of bacon in spiral pattern; place on prepared pan.
3. Broil chicken 4 minutes. Turn and broil 2 minutes. Brush with 1/4 cup barbecue sauce, broil 2 minutes.
Turn and brush with remaining 1/4 cup barbecue sauce; broil 2 minutes or until chicken is no longer pink in center.
